THE PROGRAM

Your young cricketers benefit from the knowledge and experience of our talented coaches. They

- receive coaching in batting, bowling, fielding & wicket keeping
- participate in skill drills and modified games
- receive a written report on their progress at the completion of the clinic (for those attending the full clinic).
- enjoy "Super Eights" games on the final day



With a coaching ratio of one coach to every ten children, no one gets to sit around! All coaches are well-qualified, experienced, good educators and skilled cricketers.

Each Clinic is an active, full participation event. Your child will be rewarded with new skills, new friendships and a terrific fun time under the watchful eye of experienced, caring coaches.

AWARDS

In recognition of their participation, each child attending a full clinic receives a Manly-Warringah Cricket Coaching School T-Shirt and certificate. Further awards, like cricket bats and other equipment, are made at the conclusion of the clinic for sportsmanship, enthusiastic participation and improvement.

CLOTHING

Appropriate clothing is a light-coloured shirt and tracksuit pants or shorts. A **hat and sunscreen** are essential. Please send sunscreen with your children so they can reapply it during the day.



EQUIPMENT and FOOD

Participants are encouraged to bring their own equipment. However, bats, pads, gloves and protective equipment are provided. Helmets **must** be worn when batting against a hard ball. Soft drinks and bottled water are available for purchase at \$2 each. **Food is not available** so make sure you send along enough to keep a busy child going to the end!



ENROLMENTS

WET WEATHER
