THE PROGRAM

Each Clinic is an active, full participation event. Your child will be rewarded with new skills, new friendships and a terrific fun time under the watchful eye of experienced, caring coaches.

AWARDS

In recognition of their participation, each child receives a SeaFM Cricket Coaching School T-Shirt and certificate. Further awards, like cricket bats and other equipment, are made at the conclusion of the clinic for sportsmanship, enthusiastic participation and improvement.

CLOTHING

Appropriate clothing is a light-coloured shirt and tracksuit pants or shorts. A **hat and sunscreen** are essential. Please send sunscreen with your children so they can reapply it during the day.

EQUIPMENT and FOOD

- Participants are encouraged to bring their own equipment. However, bats, pads, gloves and protective equipment are provided.
- Helmets **must** be worn when batting against a hard ball.
- Soft drinks and bottled water are available for purchase at \$2 each. **Food is not available** so make sure send along enough to keep a busy child going to the end!
